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Introduction

Green Policy

- The institution will be constituted clear policy and guidelines for the conservation and preservation of greenery and nature.
- All individuals (including teaching, non-teaching staff, and students) are encouraged to appreciate and value the importance of conserving natural resources.
- Everyone is entitled to prevent the misuse or wastage of any natural resources.
- To promote green initiatives, a Nature Club will be constituted, consisting of teaching staff and students, with the principal as the Chairman.
- An Environmental Monitoring Committee will be formed to oversee the conservation efforts within the campus.
- The Environmental Monitoring Committee will include members from the teaching and non-teaching staff, and students, with the principal as the Chairman.
- The Environmental Monitoring Committee will conduct regular audits to assess the institution's environmental impact and must submit report to the head of the institution.
- Necessary csary actions will be taken by the head of the institution to reduce the environmental degradation based on the audit report submitted by the environment monitoring committee.
- Signboards on nature conservation need to be displayed at the focal points of the institution.
- The use of eco-friendly materials is encouraged and emphasis is placed on the conservation of natural resources, including initiatives such as tree planting and biodiversity preservation.
